While we have listed a tentative agenda above, it is very likely to change at the last minute due to White House availability and scheduling. We appreciate your understanding that the agenda will remain flexible throughout the meeting.

We have reserved a block of sleeping rooms at The Fairmont Washington, D.C., located at 2401 M Street which is in the West End of Washington and four blocks from NAAG's office located at 2030 M Street, NW 8th floor. The Fairmont is just minutes from the White House and sits at the entrance to Historic Georgetown. Our special discounted group rate is \$289.00 single or double occupancy. The Hotel cut-off date is Friday, February 5, 2010.

Reservations should be made by calling the hotel directly at 202-429-2400 or toll free at 1-800-441-1414. Please be certain to identify yourself as a NAAG Spring Meeting attendee in order to receive the discounted group rate. The deadline for securing the special rate is February 5, 2010. After that date the group rate will not be offered.

Wireless internet access is available in the lobby lounge and guest rooms for a daily fee. The Health Club at The Fairmont is a 17,000 square foot facility, including a lap pool, exercise and weight rooms, aerobics classes, sauna, steam room, tanning booths, and a day spa. The Health Club is located on the Mezzanine level. Hours of operation are Monday – Friday 5:30 a.m. – 10:00 p.m., Saturday – Sunday 7:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m. If you become a member of the Fairmont President's Club (FPC), you will get internet access in guest rooms, lobby and Health Club Access included. There is no cost to join and no annual fee. To sign up, go to the Fairmont website at www.fairmont.com and click on the FPC tab. You will be asked a few basic questions (it takes about 5 minutes to sign up) and you will be issued your FPC membership number.

Hotel rooms in Washington, D.C. in March can be difficult to secure. Individual reservations may be made and canceled at the hotel 72 hours before arrival without penalty. We urge you to make a reservation early even if your plans are uncertain. Note: Check-in time is after 4:00 p.m. and checkout time is 1:00 p.m.

Airports, Cab & Super Shuttle Fares

Three major airports service the Washington, D.C. area.

Ronald Reagan National Airport is approximately a 15-minute ride to The Fairmont by cab and the cost is approximately \$25.00. If you wish to travel by Metro take the Blue Line towards Addison Road directly to the Foggy Bottom stop for \$1.60.

Dulles International Airport is approximately a one-hour drive to the hotel. Cab fare is approximately \$60.00 each way.

Baltimore Washington International Airport in Baltimore, MD, about 1 hour away sometimes has deeply discounted flights. Transportation to Washington, D.C. is by cab (approximately \$100.00) or by train. Leave plenty of time to travel between the cities.

Super Shuttle runs from either Dulles, Reagan National Airport or BWI. Reservations can be made in advance by calling (800) BLUEVAN one day in advance of your departure.

From Dulles Airport, Super Shuttle picks up passengers at curb 1F. Look for the Blue and Gold Super Shuttle signs. One-way fare to The Fairmont is \$26.00 plus \$10.00 for each additional person and you may pay the driver by cash or credit card.

From Ronald Reagan National Airport, look for ticket booths for the Super Shuttle and Washington Flyer, located at various points throughout the terminal. Look for the sign that reads "Super Shuttle and Washington Flyer Tickets." One way fare to The Fairmont is \$12.00 plus \$8.00 for each additional person. The van picks up passengers outside the baggage claim area. For return transportation to either airport from The Fairmont Hotel, call Super Shuttle at 1-800-BLUEVAN one day in advance of your departure to arrange for pick-up at the hotel.

From BWI the one-way fare is \$31.00 and \$10.00 for each additional person. The Super Shuttle desk is located between bag claims 6 and 7. The ticket counter is open between the hours of 6:00 AM and 2:00 AM. During other times please call 888-826-2700 to arrange service.

Registration Fees

The registration fee for each Friend of NAAG is \$895 those who register by February 15. After February 15 the fee is \$995 for each Friend. The spouse/guest fee is \$150 and then \$200 after February 15. Please make a copy of the registration form and mail with your check for any spouse/guest fee.

As you know, we are offering a substantial savings to those who wish to register for both the February 8-10 Presidential Initiative Summit “Virtual World – Real Crime” and the Spring Meeting. The combined fee is \$1,600 for each Friend of NAAG, and \$250 for Spouse/Guests. That represents a \$290 savings for each Friend and \$150 savings for Spouse/Guest, off the regular registration fee. If you are planning to attend both meetings, we urge you to take advantage of this registration combination.
