## Exhibit F to Christie/IAG Settlement Agreement Dated as of April \_\_\_\_\_, 2009

- 1. The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services ("HFS") will submit data reports to counsel for IAG and Christie for 2009 through April 30, 2012 that show aggregate Medical Homes provided and aggregate number of primary care Wards and Disabled Children seen by providers in Champaign County, Illinois, including Christie, Carle Clinic Association, P.C., Community Health Improvement (FNHC, et al.), and Provena Service Corp. Reports will be issued as of 6/30 and 9/30 and 12/31 of 2009, as of 3/30, 6/30 and 9/30 and 12/31 of 2010 and 2011, and as of 3/31 of 2012. HFS will, in each report, identify to Christie those Christie patients classified by HFS as Wards or Disabled Children.
- 2. HFS confirms its position that Christie's issuance of the following public statement in conjunction with settlement of pending litigation between the IAG and Christie would not violate or conflict with any applicable statute, regulation, or rule on provider solicitation, marketing, or communication with Illinois Medicaid patients:

"Christie will continue participation in the Illinois Health Connect Program through April 30, 2012 by certain Christie Primary Care Providers in Champaign County, Illinois area, in accordance with IHC Program rules, regulations, and eligibility requirements now in effect, and Christie presently is accepting eligible new IHC Patients in the Champaign County area who designate a Christie Primary Care Provider under the IHC Program."
